#### Who we are

- The cancer transformation programme started in 2017/18 and is hosted by the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital (NNUH).
- The programme's Senior Responsible Officer (SRO) is the Chief Executive of the James Paget University Hospital (JPUH).
- Our team has grown over the last few years and has 9 members working across the Norfolk & Waveney (N&W) Integrated Care System (ICS).
- Our team is made up of a Clinical Lead, Head of Cancer, Clinical Advisor, 4 Project Managers, a Project Officer (Patient and Public Involvement Lead), and a Team Administrator.
- We liaise and work closely with stakeholders across N&W to include the three acute hospitals, primary care, patient/carer representatives, county councils, voluntary groups, social care and Healthwatch to help people affected by cancer receive the right care at the right time and in the right place.

#### What we do

- The aim of the programme is to support the local delivery of the <u>NHS Long Term</u> Plan Cancer.
- The main objectives are to lead and implement system redesign projects that support continued recovery of cancer services, earlier diagnosis of cancer, faster diagnosis, better treatment and personalised care, workforce redesign, improved equity of access to cancer care linking to our <u>Core 20 plus 5 values</u> and increased patient/public involvement in cancer transformation.
- Funding for the programme is bid for on an annual basis via the National Cancer Action Team.
